





- Nests of Rough-Legged Hawks sometimes contain the bones of caribou along with sticks.
- Rough-Legged Hawks get their name from their feathered legs. There are one of only three American hawks whose legs have feathers all the way to the toes.












- Swainson's Hawks have one of the longest migrations of any raptors. They can fly over 6000 miles in less than two months.
- During their migration, Swainson's Hawks will flock together, sometimes numbering in the thousands.






- Before bison were killed off, Ferruginous Hawks often made their nests from bison bones and wool.
- The Ferruginous Hawk is one of only three American hawks who has feathers all the way to their toes.




